1. When did section 31 of the Access to Justice Act 1999 come into force?

2 June 2003 (SI 2003/1241)

Hard Copy

- Halsbury's Is It In Force: This is arranged chronologically so go to the 1999 Acts and then they are listed alphabetically. This is only updated once a year so you also need to go to the "Noter Up" that includes more recent information.

Electronic

- JustCite: Enter the name of the Act then select section 31 from the Outline. The details are under the Amendments section.
- LexisNexis Butterworths: Under the "Commentary Tab", select source as "Halsbury's Is it in Force". Then search for the name of the act.
- Westlaw: Once you have located the act by searching under its title and provision number, go to "Links for", then "Analysis" and this will provide you with commencement information and in force date.
